The "Integrity Training" at the GWOPA Assembly on 2 November 2024, facilitated by the GWOPA member organization Water Integrity Network (WIN), presents a valuable learning opportunity for water and sanitation utility staff. WIN brings extensive experience in developing and applying water integrity tools with utilities, ensuring that participants benefit from expert guidance.

The training focuses on enhancing understanding of key integrity concepts in the sector, using the TAPA Framework (Transparency, Accountability, Participation, and Anticorruption) to address how integrity failures impact service delivery.

 By exploring real-life integrity dilemmas through group exercises and discussions, participants gain practical tools and strategies to navigate ethical challenges in their work. This hands-on approach, combined with networking opportunities, equips utility staff with the skills needed to foster a culture of integrity, thereby strengthening the delivery of water and sanitation services and upholding human rights in their communities.

In March 2023, as part of the Water Action Agenda, GWOPA committed to establishing at least 100 new Water and Sanitation-focused Operator Partnerships (WOPs/SWOPs) by 2030. In line with this pledge, GWOPA's Sanitation Strategy outlines two key goals:

- Accelerating universal access to sanitation by leveraging SWOPs to transform GWOPA's approach to sanitation, involving all stakeholders.
- Committing that at least 35 of the new partnerships by 2030 will specifically focus on sanitation (SWOPs).

As part of this commitment, GWOPA brings together sanitation experts to discuss strategies for scaling SWOPs and expanding sanitation services. The discussions will focus on designing and developing SWOPs as a powerful, low-cost investment tool to enhance operational efficiency and strengthen sanitation services, making them more efficient and resilient.

Introducing the basic concepts of integrity in water and sanitation, including the TAPA Framework (Transparency, Accountability, Participation and Anti-corruption). Participants will understand how integrity failures influence water and sanitation service delivery and what role utilities play in strengthening integrity and ensuring the human rights to water and sanitation. Participants will get to know the InWASH tool, a detailed methodology to launch an integrity management process including:

- Integrity Assessment: 15 straightforward indicators to benchmark current integrity practices,
- Descriptions of typical integrity risks that can undermine the work of water and sanitation service providers,
- A business model exercise to evaluate how poor integrity impacts a utility's core functions and how it will improve
- A description of more than 50 practical tools to inspire a change management process that fits the needs and realities of each utility.

This section will explore how integrity concepts are put into practice through practical examples that demonstrate integrity dilemmas that water and sanitation professionals may face.
